45TH ANNUAL ATHLETIC MEET

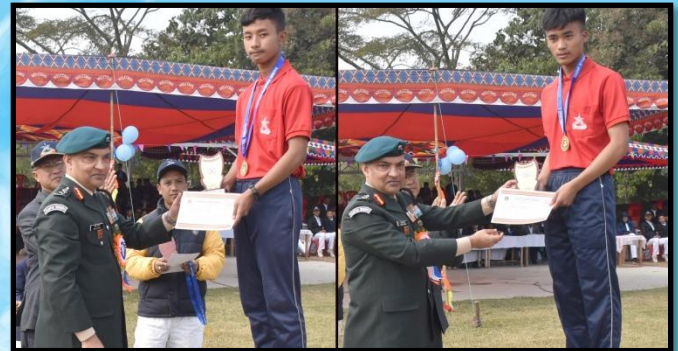
